YOUR CARE

At Elm Hall, we care for people with a wide range of needs. Some of our residents live with a great degree of independence supported discreetly by staff with those little elements of day to day living that they find challenging. Others may need more intensive support which can include assistance with daily care and activities of living. We can cater for most complex medical needs such as catheter and stoma care, feeding tubes, palliative care and support for those living with dementia and alzheimers disease. Most important of all is the social care and activities provided to promote a good quality of life and to ensure every resident has a meaningful day filled with interaction and engagement.

NURSING CARE

Our team of NMBI Registered Nurses and QQI accredited Healthcare Assistants are skilled in providing compassionate individualised care for all your activities of daily living. We develop and constantly update your individual plan of care with you and your loved ones to make sure you get the help you need to live well.



MEDICAL CARE AND MEDICATION MANAGEMENT

At Elm Hall, our experienced General Practitioner (GP) co-ordinates and manages the healthcare needs of our residents supported by the nursing staff. The GP holds a clinic on site and provides emergency cover outside of hours through the Kildare and West Wicklow Doctor on call service (K-DOC). We are proud to have partnered with Median Healthcare to provide a comprehensive medicines management service. The Clinical Pharmacist at Median is available to residents and their families to discuss medicines management and any queries they may have and provide education on best use of medicines.

ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

Our team is supported by a full multidisciplinary team including physiotherapy, dietician, speech and language therapy, podiatry, optical care and tissue viability nurses. Many of these services are included or are available through HSE schemes. Further details are available on request.

SOCIAL AND ACTIVITIES PROGRAMME

Social Care and meaningful activities are the key to our residents wellbeing. Our Activities Co-ordinators prepare and co-ordinate our 7 day social and activities plan to provide activity, engagement, fun and community integration at Elm Hall. One to one activities and group activities are available. This is further supported by our network of trained, vetted volunteer visitors from [Grandpal](#), and a network of visiting entertainers and social care providers such as Irish Therapy Dogs.

The physical environment at Elm Hall is designed to maximise comfort, safety and quality of care.

DINING EXPERIENCE

Our Catering staff provide a range of delicious meal options throughout the day including snacks. Breakfast is usually served in each residents room and a choice of main meals is available at lunch time and tea-time. Special diets can be catered for. The menu is developed with input from a nutritional consultant. Residents input and feedback is an integral part of menu planning.

HOUSEHOLD, LAUNDRY, MAINTENANCE

Housekeeping and laundry services are provided daily for all residents included freshly laundered towels and sheets. Our maintenance staff are also available to help with personalising residents rooms and maintaining the home to a high standard.

SCHEDULE A VIEWING

Contact us to arrange a viewing of the nursing home. Sometimes a number of viewings is necessary to accommodate everyone involved in the decision. PRE-ADMISSION ASSESSMENT

Once you've made your decision that Elm Hall might be suitable for you or your loved one, let us know and we can arrange a pre-admission assessment.

The assessment takes 20-30 minutes. One of our nurse managers will come to visit either at home or in hospital. The purpose of the assessment is to make sure we can meet all of your needs and gather some basic information so that we can make a decision.

We will let you know the outcome of the assessment within 24 hours. In the unlikely event that we feel we can't meet your needs, we will advise you of alternative suitable services.

Once we've confirmed we can meet your needs, we will offer you a place and propose an admission date.

SCHEDULE ADMISSION

Admissions are scheduled Monday to Friday between 10:00am and 4:00pm. We will agree the date and time with you and help arrange transport if needed. We will also let you know what information you need to bring with you such as prescriptions and doctors letters.
